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## The Hook Green Walk

Walk overview:

| Distance: | 4 miles $(6 \mathrm{~km})$ |
| :--- | :--- |
| Time: | $2-2.5$ hours |
| Description: | Heading west from Lamberhurst you willvisit the village of <br>  <br>  <br>  <br> Hook Green and pass through many fields within the <br> wonderful Kent countryside. |



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## WALKS OF THE VINEYARD No. 5

Leave The Vineyard, turn right and immediately turn right again onto the road. Keep walking along it for about 0.3 miles ( 500 m ) until the 'Misty Meadow Farm" signpost (there is a "Public Footpath' signpost too). Turn left onto a small road and after 50 yards ( 50 m ) go through the gate with the sign 'Footpath' on the right (1). Follow the trail in between the fields to the corner and continue along it into the forest. Carry on through the forest (over two bridges and through one metal gate) until the second gate. Walk through it, climb over the following style and continue along the edge of the field until a metal gate leading into the farm. Go through it and follow the trail for about 50 yards $(50 \mathrm{~m}$ ) further until a post with yellow arrows on the right.
Tum right and keep walking along the edge of the field and later continue straight through it. Go through a metal gate with a yellow arrow (2), down the slope, over a small bridge and up the opposite slope. Climb over the style, cross a small road and go up a few steps (follow a 'Public Footpath' signpost). Keep walking straight along the edge of the field until a wooden gate (3). Walk through it, turn right and continue along the edge of the field to the comer, turn left and keep walking down the hill along the next edge. Go through a metal gate and continue straight along the trail in between the trees. Later go through the next metal gate and follow the edge of the fields until the corner by a building. Walk through the metal gate, join a small road and keep walking straight until a bigger road.

Tum right onto the bigger road and keep walking along it for about 0.3 miles ( 500 m ) until a crossroad with a bigger road and traditional signpost (4). Turn right onto the road and continue along it for about 0.2 miles ( 300 m ) until a 'Public Footpath' stone on the left (it might be a little bit of a challenge to find it as it may be hidden in the bushes). Turn left and follow the trail diagonally through the field to the opposite corner and climb over the style into another field. Continue straight along the trail, through a small wooden gate and down the hill along the fence.
Tum left onto the road and immediately behind the gate of 'Fumace Mill' (for more information see The Vineyard Walk - no. 2) turn right and walk through a small white gate (5). Keep walking along the edge of the field and over a metal bridge into the next field. Follow the edge of this field until the corner (you can see a track leading next to it). Turn right onto the track and keep walking along it for about 0.25 miles ( 400 m ) (later it becomes a tarmac road) until a small set of steps on the left.

## WALKS OF THE VINEYARD No. 5

Walk up the steps and continue straight along the trail through the vineyards for about 0.4 miles $(600 \mathrm{~m})$. At the end go down a few steps and turn right onto a road. Follow the road for about 50 yards ( 50 m ) until a crossroad with small roads. Turn right and keep walking along the small road until The Vineyard.
