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Around The Land of Langley

Walk overview:

Distance:	4 miles (6.5 km)
Time:	1.5 – 2 hours
Description:	Through fields, heading East of the Potting Shed, around
	Burnt Barn Farm and beyond.



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SHED

Leave The Potting Shed, cross the road and turn right onto the pavement following Horseshoes Lane. Keep walking along the pavement for about 0.3 miles (500m) and then keep left (follow the signpost to Leeds and Village Hall). Continue along the pavement for about 0.15 miles (200m) until the 'Public footpath' signpost and wooden gate on the left hand side. Turn left onto the footpath and keep walking along it through orchards **(1)** for about 0.15 miles (200m) until the first row of apple trees on the right. Turn right behind it and continue along the apple trees to the corner of the orchard. In the corner keep walking straight for an extra 10 yards (10m), and turn left towards the stile in the bushes **(2)**.

Climb over the stile and keep walking straight along the bushes (bushes are on the left hand side and the field in on the right, and later bushes are on the right hand side while the field is on the left **(3)**) until a wooden post with two yellow arrows and a wooden gate ahead of you. Turn right and follow the footpath until a stile. Climb over the stile and turn right onto the road. Carry on along it for about 30 yards (30m) until a 'Public footpath signpost' on the left.

Turn left and follow the footpath straight through the fields for about 0.25 miles (400m) until it bears left. Turn left and carry on along it to the close trees ahead and then turn right in between them. Follow the trail through the bushes and later between the fences (4) for about 0.2 miles (300m) until a road. Turn right onto it and continue along it until a 'Public Bridleway' stone on the left.

Turn left and carry on straight along the bridleway for about 0.5 miles (800m), past the pole **(5)** until a road. Turn right onto the road and keep walking along it for about 0.3 miles (500m) until a 'Public footpath' signpost and metal barrier on the left hand side **(6)**. Leave the road and follow the track for about 0.3 miles (500m) until a trail crossroad with a 3-stem tree in the centre. Keep right and in 20 yards (20m) keep right again and turn onto a track. Follow the track for about 0.5 miles (800m) until the track bears sharply left while the trail continues straight. Keep walking straight along the trail for about 0.15 miles (200m) until a T-junction with another path. Turn right onto it and follow it past the building on your right hand side until a road.

Turn right onto the road and follow it until a crossroad with Horseshoes Lane. Turn left onto it (in the direction of Maidstone and Village Hall) and keep walking along the lane for about 0.25 miles (400m) until a crossroad with Lacey Close on your left hand side. Turn left onto Lacey Close and keep walking until the car park, then just before it turn right onto a pavement between houses. Follow the pavement for about 50 yards (50m) and then continue straight along Porters Walk until a crossroad with Heath Road. Cross the main road and carry on along Green Lane for about 0.1 miles (150m) until a 'Public footpath' signpost on the right. Turn right onto the footpath and keep walking along it through the bushes until the field. Follow the footpath through the field over a concrete bridge until you get into the bushes again. Continue along the footpath through the bushes and between the fences until a road.

(If you cross the road, turn left and follow the pavement for about 100 yards (100m) and you will see the entrance gate of the church of Saint Mary, where you can explore the church grounds)

Cross the road, turn right and keep walking along the pavement for about 0.1 miles (150m) until The Potting Shed on the right.
